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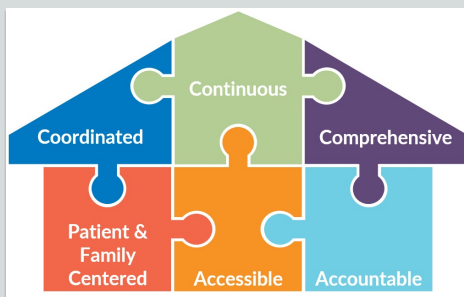

This is a free discussion-based forum for Oregon health system transformation champions to engage in peer-to-peer learning and networking. CCO, clinic and other innovative health system leaders will present projects and discuss learnings focused on three CCO incentive metrics:

- Increasing effective contraceptive use to reduce unintended pregnancy
- Reducing tobacco prevalence
